

# CLASSROOM RULES

Please read the following classroom behavior policy carefully with your child. Both you and your child should sign & date the bottom of the document to show that it was read. This form should then be kept in the student binder for the remainder of the year. Thank you.

## The Big 5 (Our Classroom Rules):

1. Always be your best & do your best.
2. Respect all people & property.
3. Follow directions & instructions the first time.
4. Have self control.
5. Listen to others.

## If not following the rules a student will receive reminders and possibly face consequences:

- Steps 1 & 2: Receive up to two verbal warnings.
- Step 3: Leave the room for Processing & Reflection.
- Step 4: Two 'PRs' in a week will result in lunch detention.
- Step 5: Two lunch detentions will result in after school detention.
- Step 6: Two after school detentions will result in Friday school.
- Some behavior can directly result in steeper consequences, depending on the seriousness of the action (please refer to the attached School-wide Discipline Policy for more information). Likewise students can be excused of a warning with demonstration of a clear effort to change behavior.
- Following the rules will result in a happier classroom atmosphere for all students along with the rewards of positive feelings, better grades, positive notes, goodies, and more.

Parents will always be informed of behaviors resulting in a Step 5 consequence or higher and any repeat behaviors or other behaviors that become a concern. Minor offenses to the rules will not always be reported home, but that does not mean that they are not being addressed. It is important that students take responsibility for their own actions throughout the school day and are able to show a good effort to change negative behavior on their own.
